# About:

As an intern with PTFC Camps, you will get an inside look at what it's like to work for a professional sports organization and a world class youth camp program. Marketing camps: Spring and Summer

- Attend events, youth tournaments, etc. as a PTFC Camps representative
- Represent PTFC Camps at Timbers and Thorns gamedays
- Attend weekly meetings with camp office staff on marketing progress and ideas
- Analyze marketing progress and strategy
- Give end of season presentation on improving camps

#### Administrating camps: Summer

- Once the summer begins, in addition to their marketing work, interns oversee administrative work at our camp locations
- Represent PTFC camps at our partner locations each week of the summer
- Oversee staff management at camp including tracking coaches' hours, evaluating coaches and youth camp programs

- Oversee camper safety at camp including checking in and out of campers, first aid responder, and tending to camper's needs
- Customer service representative as the first face parents see
- Transport gear to locations and setting up camp
- Ensure that camp runs smoothly, stays on schedule
- Prepare camp bin, binder, and equipment for the following week
- Any additional work assigned by the Camp Manager, Camp Lead, or any department staff
